Dear WRP Family,



Thank you for journeying with me toward my ordination. It was because of your full support and faithful prayers that I was able to continue without stopping or giving up—and finally be ordained. WRP has been more than just a parish for our family; it has truly been a family of faith. The times we've shared—through worship, prayer, meals, laughter, and tears—have all played a significant role in shaping my identity as a pastor.

My family and I were deeply moved during our Parish Combined Worship on June 29. You had clearly planned ahead and prepared food, cards, and gifts with such care to celebrate my ordination. And somehow, you even knew that I love carrot cake! We were deeply touched by your love. Thank you—truly, thank you. I feel so loved, and I am indeed a happy pastor.

Now, as I take my first steps as an ordained Elder, I do so with a renewed sense of responsibility to serve the Lord's church faithfully. I hope to be a pastor who rightly handles the Word of God and helps the gospel come alive in each person's daily life.

Please continue to pray for me and for my family. Pray that God would grant me wisdom and humility, and that I would walk steadily under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. I, too, am praying for each of your families and your children.

When it comes to faith, my parents didn't teach me just through words. Instead, they let their love, their service, and their way of life quietly shape my understanding of faith. For me, then, faith has never been separate from life—it is life. It's a way of being, a kind of culture. And now, I am trying to raise our son in that same spirit of love, hoping that our faith will naturally be woven into his life as well.

So rather than training him to pray or teaching him that he "has to" pray, we simply let him see us praying—before meals, at bedtime. Perhaps those quiet moments had a positive influence, because now, he wants to say grace every time we eat.

He recently prayed a prayer that my wife wrote down, and I translated it. He's only five years old, so some of his expressions are a bit awkward—but rather than correcting his words, we chose to honor them, trusting that God is at work in shaping his heart. I'd like to share that prayer with you:



"With the power of Your love, Heavenly Father, please fill our hearts with love. Heavenly father, please make us healthy and bless us. Please help us stay healthy.

Please bless our family. As the Lord, we love You. God is in our hearts and we can feel it. God speaks inside our hearts.

God says He loves us forever and puts love into us with His care. Amen."
