

Dear WRP Family,

We are now in the final days of summer. Did you all have a joyful time during the season? Are you ready to enjoy the beautiful autumn, when the leaves on all the trees will turn red, yellow, and brown?

For a while, I've been focusing on ministry on my page, so I haven't had the chance to share any updates about my family. Some of you have occasionally asked if there's any news about a second child, but, well... we've been plenty busy just raising Evan, so, well... not just yet... haha. Only God knows!

Anyway, this fall, our son will be starting 4K! Time really flies, doesn't it? When we first came here, he was just a 6-month-old baby, and now he's going to school! At night, when we see his long arms and legs as he sleeps,



we're often amazed. We also take time to encourage each other, acknowledging how hard we've worked to raise Evan over the past four years. And it's no secret that my wife, Esther, is very excited and looking forward to having some time for ourselves as Evan starts school!

We spent August preparing all the school supplies Evan will need—pencil cases, colored pencils, scissors, glue, and more. Since Korean is the language we feel most comfortable with, and for his cultural identity, we've raised him speaking Korean. Thanks to our love and efforts, he's exceptionally skilled at expressing and describing his thoughts, emotions, and feelings verbally, more so than most kids his age. Koreans who meet him are often amazed at his Korean and say, "Evan grew up in a village where his parents were the

only Koreans, so how is he so good at Korean?"

Of course, we do have concerns about his school life, especially since he's just started

learning English recently. We're mindful of how well he'll be able to communicate with his friends and teachers. That's why we've been teaching him simple English words and phrases needed for school and practicing them with him daily. From talking with our Korean friends and



experts raising children like us in America, we've learned that kids pick up languages quickly, and within six months to a year, he'll likely become proficient in English.

They also warned us that, in the future, we might have to work harder to ensure he doesn't forget his Korean.

Since 4K is his first experience of school life. there will be many things for him to adjust to, and he might feel stressed and tense at times. But we believe he'll make good friends and do well. I ask that whenever you think of Evan, you pray for him and his school



life, and when you see him, please encourage and cheer him on.


